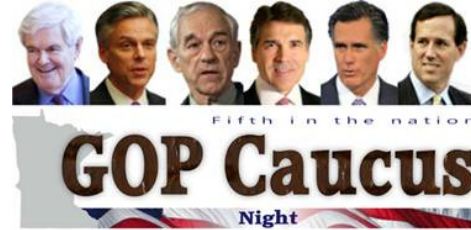




Senate District 40A Republicans

Please join us on **Tuesday, February 7th, at 7:00 pm** for your neighborhood precinct caucus. Precinct caucuses are the kickoff event and start to the 2012 campaign season. You will have the opportunity to cast a vote in the Presidential Straw Poll, the first step in choosing the Republican Presidential Candidate in 2012. The Caucus for Senate District 40A, Burnsville will be held at:

In addition to the Presidential Straw Poll we will also be electing Precinct Officers, Delegates/Alternates for the Senate District Convention to be held in March and discussing Candidates, Issues and Resolutions. The number of Delegates/Alternates to be Elected and the Meeting Rooms for each Precinct are listed below:

Burnsville Precinct #1	15 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in C100 Resource
Burnsville Precinct #2	9 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in A100 Resource
Burnsville Precinct #3	9 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in Upper Studio II-DMS
Burnsville Precinct #4	8 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in D100 Resource
Burnsville Precinct #5	6 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in A101 Classroom
Burnsville Precinct #7	10 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in B100 Resource
Burnsville Precinct #8	17 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in Commons Area
Burnsville Precinct #11	12 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in Great Room
Burnsville Precinct #12	6 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in A102 Classroom
Burnsville Precinct #17	9 Delegates/Alternates, Meeting in D101 Classroom

The statutory guidelines for Caucuses are:

1. The Precinct Caucus must stay open for at least One Hour.
2. Nominations for Election of Permanent Officers of the Precinct shall remain open for at least the first 15 minutes. They can remain open longer.
3. Election of Delegates and Alternates may begin 30 minutes after Caucus convening but must begin one hour after convening the Caucus. There is no set time to finish.
4. All voting must be by secret ballot. Minnesota Law requires a secret ballot.

Again, please join us on Tuesday, February 7, 2012 for your neighborhood Precinct Caucus. This is where it all starts and is the best way to have your voice heard!
